



BUSINESS BASICS GRANT (Round 4)

Registrations of Interest open 9am Thursday 24 November until 11.59pm on Monday 5 December 2022.

Eligible businesses who have been successful in the ballot will be invited to submit their funding application from 9am on Monday 12 December 2022 and will have until Monday 23 January 2023 to apply.

\$5000

\$5000 grants will support business owners to develop their skills and adopt best practice.

This support includes funded activities in 5 priorities:

1. Training and coaching
2. Website build or upgrades
3. Professional business advice
4. Strategic marketing services
5. Business continuity and succession.

Available funding
You may be eligible for a single up-front fixed grant payment of \$5,000 (excluding GST).

We will not fund activities with either:

- a total cost of less than \$5,000 (excluding GST)
- payments made before the approval date (you must be approved before you pay for grant-funded activities).

Detailed eligibility criteria
To be eligible for this grant, your business must:

- not have been approved for funding under Round 1, 2 or 3 of the Business Basics grants program
- have fewer than 20 employees (by head count) at the time of applying for the grant
- have an active Australian Business Number (ABN) and be registered for GST
- have headquarters in Queensland
- have an expected turnover of \$300,000 or less in the last financial year (2021–22)
- not have owners/directors that are insolvent or an undischarged bankrupt.

Application process
Registrations of Interest (ROIs) open at 9am on Thursday, 24 November 2022 and close at 11.59pm, Monday 5 December 2022. You must complete and submit an online ROI through the [DESBT SmartyGrants portal](#).

ROIs are not time sensitive and registrations can be completed anytime while the stage is open.

Not all registrations will be invited to submit a full application. You will not be able to appeal if your registration is not selected to move to Stage 2: Full application.

This grant program is competitively assessed. Not all applications will be funded.
